- ◆ **Poster** (presentation without lecture)
- ◆ **Multimedia-Presentation** (presentation without lecture).
The presentation including audio is self-explanatory and delivered on electronic media. Please note: Powerpoint-Presentations with integrated video-files which require oral comments will not be accepted as Multimedia-Presentation.
The presentation on CD or DVD must be send to the office of the German Society of ORL HNS by March 15, 2010
Length: max. 15 min.

Multiple Free Papers in addition to Posters with Short Lecture and/or Poster-Presentation (even on the same subject with changing orders of authors and/or co-authors) will not be accepted. A Multimedia-Presentation may be submitted in addition to other presentations.
