- ◆ **Multimedia presentation** (presentation without lecture). The presentation including audio is self-explanatory. Delivered on electronic media. Powerpoint-Presentations with integrated video files which require oral explanations will not be accepted as a multimedia presentation. The presentation on CD or DVD must be sent to the office of the German Society of ORL/HNS by 15<sup>th</sup> March 2012. Length: max. 15 min.
